



Dubai Maritime City Expands Maritime Capacity

Dubai Maritime City (DMC) has completed key infrastructure upgrades, reinforcing its status as a global maritime hub. The enhancements, including modernized ship lifts and new cradles, have doubled vessel handling capacity from 400 to 1,000 annually, supporting more complex shipbuilding and repair projects.



So far in 2024, DMC has serviced 296 vessels—a 16% increase in dry berth occupancy compared to last year. The expansion, along with plans for four additional ship cradles, will attract international shipbuilding companies and boost the maritime sector's growth.



INTERNATIONAL NEWS



Maersk and Hapag-Lloyd's New East-West Network Options Set for 2025

Maersk and Hapag-Lloyd have announced two East-West network options under their upcoming Gemini Cooperation, launching in February 2025. Approved by the U.S. Federal Maritime Commission, the partnership offers routes via the Suez Canal or the Cape of Good Hope.

The final decision on the route will be made in October 2024, with the Suez route expected to use around 300 vessels and the Cape option requiring 340 vessels. Both networks aim to maintain high reliability, connectivity, and sustainability, providing customers with flexible solutions.

LNG Takes the Lead in Alternative Fuel Orders

LNG has reclaimed its position as the leading alternative fuel for newbuild ships. In September 2024, LNG-fueled vessels saw a surge in orders, with nine ships compared to eight methanol-powered counterparts. This increase marks a 57% rise in LNG-capable orders for the year, contrasting with a 1% decline for methanol. The trend shift highlights LNG's growing dominance, even as container ships remain the primary adopters of alternative fuels. Despite this growth, conventional fuels still dominate the global fleet, with alternative fuels mainly used in larger vessels.

Industry News @ A Glance



French Chocolatier Pioneers with Grain de Sail III

Grain de Sail, the French Chocolatier will launch the Grain de Sail III, a revolutionary eco-friendly cargo ship, by 2027. Entering the era of wind-powered shipping, this 200-TEU vessel, designed to transport up to 3,000 tons, will achieve over 90% decarbonization with a sail area of 4,000 square meters and advanced hydrogenation technology. Its retractable daggerboards will enhance performance and sustainability on transatlantic routes.



INS Shardul Strengthens India-UAE Maritime Bonds

INS Shardul's Dubai port call marked a significant step in India-UAE naval cooperation. The visit included professional interactions at the UAE Naval Officers Training Academy, joint training with the UAE Navy, and community outreach initiatives, such as sports and yoga sessions. A Maritime Partnership Exercise with UAE's AI Quwaisat ship highlighted operational synergy and reinforced India's commitment to stability and collaboration in the Indian Ocean Region.



Dubai Maritime City Powers Up Vessel Handling

Dubai Maritime City (DMC) has expanded its ship handling capacity from 400 to 1,000 vessels annually, advancing Dubai's goal to become a global maritime leader. The expansion includes retrofitted 6,000-tonne and 3,000-tonne ship lifts, updated power substations, and new ship cradles, enhancing DMC's ability to accommodate complex projects. Covering 249 hectares, DMC now offers superior services for luxury yachts and commercial vessels, with new agreements signed to extend facility lifespan and operational efficiency.

Jebel Ali Port Sets Monthly Record of 1.4 Million TEUs

In July, DP World's Jebel Ali Port achieved a record-breaking monthly throughput, handling 1.4 million TEUs, surpassing its previous high set in 2015. This significant growth aligns with the port's robust performance in the first half of 2024, with a 3.9% year-over-year increase in total container volume.



Key drivers include strong import traffic from Asia and the expansion of Jafza, which now hosts nearly 10,500 companies. Jebel Ali's achievement highlights its role in Dubai's economic diversification and DP World's global success, with the group's total throughput reaching 42.58 million TEUs, up 6.8% from 2023.



MARITIME BRIEFS

PIL Expands LNG Fleet

Pacific International Lines (PIL) has ordered five 9,000 TEU LNG dual-fuel containerships from Hudong-Zhonghua Shipbuilding. Capable of using bio-methane, these ships align with PIL's net zero emissions goal by 2050, bringing its newbuilding campaign to 18 vessels since 2022.

ZIM's Smart Containers

ZIMIntegratedShippingServices is revolutionizing con-tainer tracking with the intro-duction of Hoopo's hoopoSenseSolartrackers.Solar-powered trackers featurea batterylife exceeding 12years, equivalent to a contain-er's full lifecycle, eliminating theneed for replacements.

KMTC-Major Fleet Upgrade

KMTC has ordered two 9,000-TEU containerships from HD Hyundai Samho, costing \$115.3 million each, set for delivery in early 2027. The intra-Asia specialist's fleet, which now tops out at 6,650 TEU, will see a major capacity boost. KMTC operates over 60 ships and ranks 17th on Alphaliner.

REGIONAL NEWS

India-UAE Food Corridor Initiative to Boost Food Security and Farmer Support

India and the UAE have announced a \$2 billion investment to create a food corridor, enhancing food security in the UAE while supporting Indian farmers. Announced at the 12th High-Level Task Force on Investments in Mumbai by Commerce Minister Piyush Goyal, the project will focus on food processing and logistics in food parks. Part of a broader \$100 billion investment strategy, this initiative aims to increase farmer incomes and generate jobs.

EJMT Officially Opens in East Java, Boosting Indonesia's Port Capacity

The East Java Multipurpose Terminal (EJMT), operated by International Container Terminal Service, Inc. (ICTSI), officially opened on October 2, 2024, in Lamongan Regency, Indonesia. Completed within 18 months, EJMT features a 300-meter quay line, a 13.5-meter deep-water draft, and two of the largest post-Panamax mobile harbor cranes in East Java.

Strategically located, the terminal is set to serve businesses in Lamongan, Tuban, and Central Java, supporting both domestic and international trade.

Indian Register of Shipping Celebrates Golden Jubilee


On October 3, 2024, the Indian Register of Shipping (IRS) celebrated its Golden Jubilee at Visakhapatnam, marking 50 years of excellence in ship classification and maritime services. The event was attended by distinguished maritime professionals and stakeholders from the East Coast, including representatives from the Indian Navy, Indian Coast Guard, shipyards, and shipowners from Kolkata, Visakhapatnam, Kakinada, Hyderabad, and Chennai.

The event underscored IRS's ongoing commitment to adapting to future challenges and trends in the sector.



India Strengthens Border with Petrapole Terminal

Union Home Minister Amit Shah inaugurated the Passenger Terminal Building and Maitri Dwar in Petrapole, enhancing India-Bangladesh connectivity. Constructed by the LPAI for Rs. 487 crores, the project aims to secure borders while encouraging trade and cultural exchange. Shah highlighted the terminal's alignment with PM Modi's 4 Ps—Prosperity, Peace, Partnership, and Progress—as a vital step toward improved regional stability and security.





First Woman Surgeon as Naval Medical Services Director

Surgeon Vice Admiral Kavita Sahai, SM, VSM, assumed command as Director General Medical Services (Navy) on October 14, 2024. With an esteemed career as a pathologist and oncopathologist, she has also led as the first woman Commandant of AMC Centre & College and Colonel Commandant of the Army Medical Corps. Recognized with the Sena Medal and Vishisht Seva Medal, her career demonstrates remarkable dedication to medical advancement in the Indian Navy.

FFFAI's 61st AGM: Driving India's Logistics Growth

Held at New Delhi's Ashoka Hotel, FFFAI's 61st AGM united logistics leaders and government officials to champion India's logistics sector. Discussions focused on workforce skilling, gender inclusion, and fostering public-private partnerships. With insights from key officials, industry veterans highlighted technology's potential in Tier-2 cities. FFFAI Chairman Mulani reiterated the federation's commitment to trade facilitation and collaboration with various ministries to ensure sector growth and international competitiveness.



ECONOMIC OUTLOOK



Saudi Arabia's Economic Growth in 2024 - Key Indicators and Trends

As of the second quarter of 2024, Saudi Arabia continues to demonstrate impressive resilience and economic diversification efforts. With its Gross Domestic Product (GDP) at constant prices reaching SAR 847.8 billion, the Kingdom remains a major player in the global economy. This growth is driven not only by its energy sector but also by strategic investments in non-oil industries and significant improvements to infrastructure supporting trade, logistics, and industry.

Merchandise Exports and Imports: June 2024

Saudi Arabia's merchandise exports for June 2024 totaled SAR 87.9 billion, with both oil and non-oil sectors contributing significantly. Meanwhile, imports reached SAR 57.7 billion, highlighting the ongoing demand for industrial goods such as machinery and equipment, vital for infrastructure and domestic industry expansion.



Top Export Destinations


Saudi Arabia maintains strong trade ties, with the United Arab Emirates (SAR 6.1 billion) and Bahrain (SAR 3.6 billion) leading as top destinations for non-oil exports in June 2024. The UAE remains a crucial trading partner due to close economic ties within the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC). Additionally, China (SAR 2.2 billion), a key global market, reinforces the Kingdom's strategic trade relationships beyond the region.

The Rise of Non-Oil Exports


At the heart of Saudi Arabia's **Vision 2030** lies the goal of reducing reliance on oil, and the growth in **non-oil exports** reflects the Kingdom's progress. In June 2024, **non-oil exports** amounted to **SAR 21.6 billion**, with key contributors including:

- 🔆 Products of Chemical and Allied Industries SAR 6.0 billion
- Plastics and Rubber – SAR 5.5 billion
- 🔆 Transport Equipment and Parts SAR 2.8 billion

This performance underscores the Kingdom's manufacturing prowess in chemicals, plastics, and industrial materials, sectors that are pivotal to its long-term economic diversification.

Saudi Arabia's import activity is closely linked to its industrial and infrastructure ambitions. In June 2024, the leading imports included:

- Machinery and Mechanical Appliances; Electrical Equipment
 SAR 14.3 billion
- 🔆 Transport Equipment and Parts SAR 6.3 billion

🔆 Products of the Chemical and Allied Industries – SAR 5.5 billion

The demand for machinery and electrical equipment indicates the Kingdom's ongoing modernization of its manufacturing and construction sectors.

Major Import Origins

Saudi Arabia's key import partners in June 2024 highlight its global trade connections, with China remaining the largest source of imports:

- 🔆 China SAR 17.6 billion
- 🔆 United States SAR 6.6 billion
- 🔆 United Arab Emirates SAR 4.5 billion

China's dominant position as a trade partner is expected, given its role as the world's largest exporter and manufacturer of industrial goods. Meanwhile, the United States remains a crucial partner, particularly for advanced technology and equipment, while UAE continues to play a key role as a logistics hub for goods moving into Saudi Arabia.


Saudi Vision 2030: A Framework for the Future

Saudi Vision 2030 is a comprehensive reform plan introduced by Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman in 2016. The core aim of the vision is to diversify the Kingdom's economy by reducing its dependence on oil, fostering innovation, promoting sustainable practices, and establishing Saudi Arabia as a global hub for trade, tourism, and investment.


- ✤ Infrastructure Development: Vision 2030 of Saudi Arabia includes plan for modernizing ports and logistics hubs to handle increased trade volumes.
- Economic Diversification: To reduce the dependence on oil, the Kingdom facilitates non-oil exports like petrochemicals, plastics, and transport equipment making up a significant portion of non-oil exports.
- Job Creation: As Saudi Arabia invests in its logistics infrastructure, the industry is expected to create thousands of jobs for Saudis, contributing to the Vision 2030 goal of reducing unemployment.
- Sustainability Initiatives: Vision 2030 emphasizes sustainability. The shipping industry is also evolving by embracing greener practices such as fuel-efficient vessels and reduced emissions.
- Trade Connectivity: By improving port efficiency and establishing new trade routes, the shipping industry enhances Saudi Arabia's connectivity to global markets.

The Importance of Crude Oil Exports

Despite efforts to diversify, Saudi Arabia remains the world's largest oil exporter. In 2021, the Kingdom exported 2,273 million barrels of crude oil, with 77% of these exports destined for Asia and the Far East. The top destinations for Saudi crude oil were:



This data reflects the enduring significance of Saudi crude oil to global markets, particularly in Asia, which remains the largest consumer of energy resources from the Middle East. While the Kingdom is expanding its non-oil export portfolio, oil remains a critical driver of national revenue and economic influence globally.



Oil Exports: The Pillar of the Economy

Despite diversification, **oil exports** remain central to Saudi Arabia's economy. In 2021, the Kingdom exported **2,273 million barrels of crude oil**, with **77%** of these exports destined for **Asia and the Far East**. The top destinations for Saudi oil include:

★ Asia and the Far East - 77% ★ Western Europe - 8.4% ★ North America - 7.1% These figures reflect the ongoing global reliance on Saudi crude, particularly in energy-hungry markets like Asia.

While oil remains a cornerstone of Saudi Arabia's economy, the Kingdom's strategic focus on non-oil exports and industrial modernization is paving the way for sustainable, diversified growth. With significant investments in infrastructure, trade relations, and manufacturing capacity, Saudi Arabia is positioning itself as both a leader in energy and a growing force in global trade and industry.



Port Klang - Malaysia

Port Klang, Malaysia's busiest port, is strategically located on the West Coast, just 70 km from Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA). Situated at the northern tip of the Straits of Malacca, Port Klang is a natural harbour surrounded by islands, offering safe access for vessels. Handling approximately 38% of Malaysia's international trade, it's a vital hub for the nation's economy.



Trade Impact

Port Klang is crucial for Malaysia's exports, including timber, rubber, palm oil, and petroleum goods. Imports include steel coils, machine equipment, and fruits. Westport handles 75% of the port's container traffic and can accommodate the world's largest vessels. North Port also plays a key role in handling roll-on/roll-off (Ro-Ro) cargo, including automobiles.
